Welcome to Year 3! Autumn is a busy term full of learning and we cannot wait to get started!

Maths As Mathematicians, the children will be concentrating on place value using 2 and 3 digit numbers. Children will be taught to write numbers in words and numerals and order and partition numbers up to 100 and 1000. Mental and written methods for addition and subtraction will then be a focus. The children will also be concentrating on multiplication and division facts using their times tables. Children will be solving multiplication and division of 2 and 3 digit num-

In writing, we will begin by concentrating on sentence structure and using punctuation accurately. They will be taught how to identify and use, nouns, verbs, adjectives, adverbs and prepositions and use them effectively in their writing. They will also be practising their handwriting daily.

This term, we will start by exploring descriptive language and creating our own setting and character descriptions.

Children will have spellings to learn on a weekly basis

Science In our 'Movement and Feeding' topic, the children will be learning about healthy eating and the functions of our skeleton and muscles. Then, we will be moving on to find out about 'Rocks and Soils', including comparing and grouping different types of rocks.

PSHE This term will be focusing on 'Relationships' and we will be learning about different types of families

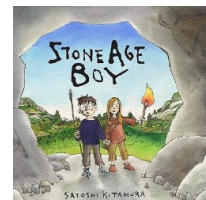
